

Windows program HyperTerminal can be used to transfer data from the serial COM port to another computer.

A 9-pin serial cable with a Null Modem (pins 2 & 3 are switched) is require to connect the two computer serial ports

Open the HyperTerminal program found under the program folder Accessories.

Establish a new connection by pulling down the file window.

It will probably assume that you want to connect through the Modem so you need to select COM1 from the pick list on the Connect to window. Then select settings to select baud rate and protocol so both computers are the same.

Then pull down the Transfer window and set one computer up to receive the file (select what directory you want) and set the other computer up to send the file.

1. On the computer to send – pull down Call window and select connect
2. On the receive computer pull down call window and select connect
3. On the send computer pull down the transfer window and select send
4. On the receive computer pull down the transfer window and select recieve
